SLS supports local chapters by training adult advisors, training student chapter members/leaders, hosting student-led conferences, providing materials that correlate activities with research, providing grants, and disseminating evidence-based research and strategies about preventing teen ATOD use and other self-destructive pressures through participatory experiences for

youth.




Below: Addiction posters made during SLS Prime for Life Program.




